## 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Family Concert

### Cover Contest!

The Vermont Philharmonic Orchestra will be performing its second annual Family Concert on **Sunday, March 28, 2010 at 3:30 P.M.** at the Barre Opera House.

This year's concert is inspired by American history and invention. Concert highlights include a performance by Cecilia Brauer of the New York Metropolitan Opera Orchestra on the Armonica (or glass harmonica), an instrument invented by Benjamin Franklin; an original piece composed by a young Vermont musician through the Vermont Midi Project; guest appearances by the Green Mountain Youth Symphony and members of the Norwich University Band; and opportunities for audience participation by all ages.

**Vermont students in grades 4 through 8 (including homeschoolers in those age ranges) are invited to submit original artwork for the cover of the program for the Family Concert. The submission deadline is February 19, 2010.** Two illustrations will be chosen, one for the front cover of the program, and one for the back cover. Winners will have their art displayed on the concert program, and will be awarded a pair of season tickets to the Vermont Philharmonic Orchestra.

Submissions of original artwork, which may be done in any medium including computer-aided, (or a hi-resolution scan of the artwork, at least 300 ppi) in 8 ½" by 11" format, with the students name, age, and school (or home address, if applicable) clearly identified on the back or on an attached sheet, may be sent by mail no later than February 19<sup>th</sup> to:
